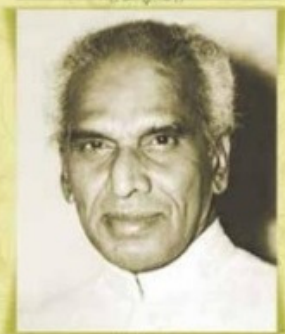
I Believe...

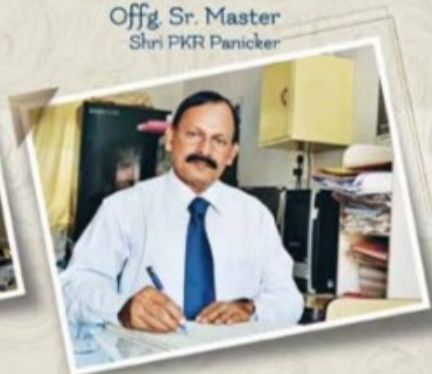

Principal's School Annual Report 2012-13

Honorable Chief Guest of the evening, Shri K Jose Cyniac, IAS, Chief Secretary, Govt of Kerala, distinguished guests, esteemed parents, members of staff and my dear cadets a warm welcome to you all.

On this solemn occasion of the 51st Annual Day Celebration of our School we are honoured to have Shri K Jose Cyniac, IAS amidst us. I am extremely grateful to him for having graciously accepted our invitation despite of his hectic schedule.

Sir, I am sure that your benign presence on this occasion will be a great source of motivation to all of us.

On this befitting occasion I shall now present before you a wide spectrum of activities and events carried out in the School during the current academic session 2012-13.

Sainik School Kazhakoottam is one of the 24 Sainik Schools in the country and it was established with a humble of 150 cadets started at Military Station Pangode in 1962. It has come a long way since its inception in making a significant mark as an educational institution of high repute in our state of Kerala. Apart from our basic aim of preparing the boys for entry into the National

Defence Academy, the training imparted in this school shape the students socially and create a meaningful approach to their life in general in order to emerge as responsible citizens of India and leaders in different walks of life.

New Admissions

After the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination in last January and selection procedure thereafter 86 cadets were admitted to the school in the beginning of the current session. 76 in Class VI and 10 in Class IX. The present school strength as on today is 649 including 611 Boarders and 38 Day Scholars.

Academics

Despite busy schedule of various regular co-curricular and extracurricular activities, Academics continue to be our prime concern and top priority. As in the past, this year too our academic achievements have been good with 100% pass in Classes X and 98% XII CBSE Board Exam held in March 2012.

Of the 96 cadets who appeared in, Class X, 91 secured CGPA above 7.5 and the remaining 05 cadets secured CGPA above 6.0. Nine cadets were awarded merit

certificate by CBSE for securing A1 for all subjects. Cdt Aravind P K, Cdt Akash K R, Cdt Pranay Rajiv, Cdt Vignesh S Kartha, Cdt Hariha U G, Cdt Anil Mohan, Cdt Vishnu U S, Cdt Narayanan B Pillai and Cdt R M Ramchandar were awarded CBSE Merit Card for the year 2012 X Board Examination.

In Class XII, of the 50 cadets who appeared, 14 secured distinctions, 30 secured first divisions and 04 secured second divisions. Cadet Sibin Babu topped the list of successful candidates by securing 88.6% in class XII. He is currently undergoing training in the NDA.

In-service Training for Sainik School Teachers

An Inservice Training Programme for Sainik School Teachers was successfully organized in this school from 11 May to 21 May 12. 125 Teachers from 74 Sainik Schools attended the same. Interactive sessions were conducted involving eminent personalities like Mr TP Sreenivasan IFS, Vice Chairman, Kerala State Higher Education Council, Mr RP Sharma, Academic Consultant, CBSE New Delhi, Dr Soumi Awasthi, Scientist F, Defence Institute of Psychological Research (DRDO), Dr Chandraprasad Sreedhar, Clinical Psychologist, Mrs Anvinder J Singh,

Educational Psychologist from NCERT and Mrs Anju I, Institute of Advanced Studies in Education.

Legal Literacy Workshop

Lessons in Law, a Legal Literacy workshop for Social Studies teachers of CBSE & ICSE Schools was organised in this school on 16 Nov 12. 28 Teachers from 21 CBSE Schools participated in this programme. Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge Shri. Sudheendra Kumar inaugurated the workshop.

Adv Dhuvana Chandran Nair was the main resource person.

National Defence Academy

Our first batch of students joined NDA in 1968 and till date more than 850 alumni have been awarded President's Commissions in the Armed Forces. Some of them have been conferred gallantry awards for the services for the sacrifices rendered to the nation during war and peace. Regular NDA preparatory classes are arranged for the boys to prepare them for the UPSC written examination.

47 Cadets appeared in the UPSC Exam for 128 NDA Course, 22 cadets qualified at the exam, 11 cadets qualified in SGB, 03 cadets joined NDA and 06 cadets

joined Naval Academy. 48 Cadets re-appeared in the UPSC Exam for 129 NDA Course. 11 cadets qualified the exam, out of these 05 cadets had already joined 128 course and remaining 06 cadets qualified SGB, and 05 of them will soon join NDA/NA. The UPSC written examination for entry into the 130th NDA course was held on 19 Aug 12. 82 cadets of Class XII appeared in the UPSC examination. The results are awaited. In the previous year's batch of Class XII, altogether total number selected is 16/48 (33%).

Sports and Games

Facilities for playing almost all major games (Football, Hockey, Volleyball, Tennis, Basketball, Cricket and Badminton) and participation in athletic track and field events exist in the School campus. Besides these, the Cadets take up indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess and Carroms. Participation in the games for all the boys is compulsory and one hour in the evening in the daily routine has been earmarked for this purpose. The School has a modern swimming pool and all Cadets have a programmed Swimming Classes. Cadets are also exposed to activities such as Karate and Yoga.

72 cadets participated in the South Zone Inter Sainik School Sports & Games Meet held at Sainik School Amaravathi Nagar from 02 Jul 12 to 07 Jul 12.

Col N J Nair AC, KC Memorial Inter School Debate Competition was held at Sainik School Kazhakoottam on 10 Oct 2012. 22 schools from in and around Thiruvananthapuram, took part in this competition. Finally it was Arya Central School, Thiruvananthapuram who emerged as Winners, St Thomas Residential School, and Sainik School Kazhakoottam won the Second and Third positions. Shri TP Sreenivasan IFS, (Retd) Executive Vice Chairman, Kerala State Hr. Edn. Council graced the

function as Chief Guest and gave away the prizes to the winners.

Capt Harshan Memorial Inter School Basketball Tournament was held from 11 Oct 12 to 13 Oct 12. Fourteen schools in and around Trivandrum participated in this prestigious tournament. Shri PK Subash, Deputy Director General, Doordarshan Kendra, Thiruvananthapuram graced the function as Chief Guest. All the matches were keenly contested displaying the true spirit of sportsmanship. The final match was played between Sainik School Kazhakoottam and St. Joseph School Trivandrum. St. Joseph School Trivandrum emerged as winners and lifted the coveted trophy and a cash prize of Rs 3,000/- The runners up team, Sainik School Kazhakoottam was awarded a cash prize of Rs 2,000/-.

Co-curricular Activities

To bring forth the latent talents of the Cadets, Inter House Competitions were held in Recitation, Declamation, Quiz, Essay Writing, Calligraphy, Spelling Bee, and Debate. Wide exposure is also given to the cadets by allowing them to participate in various literary competitions conducted by the leading schools in Thiruvananthapuram.

Our cadets participated in many inter-school competitions held at Trivandrum International School, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, S N Public School, Christ Nagar International School, St Thomas School etc and won numerous prizes in events such as English Debate, Elocution, Recitation, Essay Writing, Malayalam elocution, extempore speech, Young scientist programme, Painting competition etc.

36 cadets visited Satchidananda Jethi Nikethan International School, Mettupalayam, Tamil Nadu and participated in the CBSE South Zone Hockey Tournament held from 05 Oct 12 to 08 Oct 12. Our School was the Runner's up.





NCC Activities

With initiative of the Registrar, Offg OC, NCC Coy NCC Annual Training Camp for our cadets of Classes VIII to XII was conducted in the school itself from 30 Sep 12 to 09 Oct 12. The cadets were exposed to various NCC training activities like map reading, route march, field craft, range firing and weapon training during the camp. Five cadets of Class XII attended the Republic Day Camp held in Jan 2012 at New Delhi. All along the course of preparatory camps, they performed exceedingly well and to top it all, Cdt Ronnie I Jacob won the Prime Minister's Silver Medal for the second best cadet in the Country (Army Division) at the culmination of the event. He also attended the Prime Minister's Rally.

Being a good debater, Ronnie was selected as the Master of Ceremony at the all India level for the NCC cultural programme. He was presented with a cash award of Rs.5600/- and a memento by Shri PK Abdu Rubb, Hon'ble Minister for Education, Government of Kerala and a cash award of Rs.5000/- from NCC Directorate for his outstanding achievements and bringing laurels to the school & state. This is the fifth time that Sainik School Kazhakoottam is winning Prime Minister's Medal on Republic Day.

The party visited Necklace Road, Lumbini Park, Salarjung Museum, Charminar, Artillery Centre, Golconda Fort, Ramoji Film City, Air Force Academy and I Max. Cadets of Class XII went on a Motivational Tour to Naval Academy Ezhimala & Wayanad from 05 Sep 12 to 09 Sep 12. Class XI went on a Motivational Tour NDA Kadakwasla, Pune and Mumbai from 18 Oct 12 to 26 Oct 12. 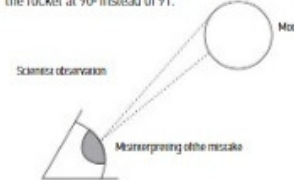

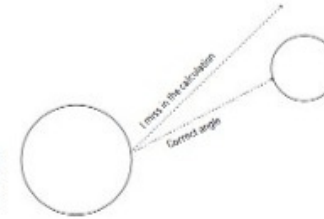
This is the secret agent which spies on everyone. We need this agent in many or every way in our lives. We don't even call it but it comes for our help. That's the quality of agent MM.

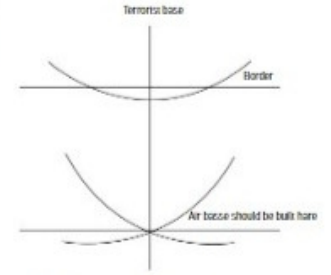
Even if the mistake had been of 0.1 degree, then the rocket wouldn't reach the moon, the rocket would miss it and go elsewhere.

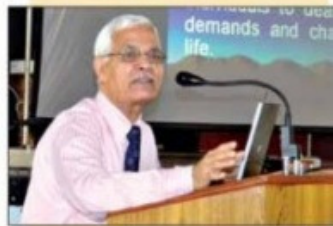
In-service Training

A primitive tribe that lives by hunting has held a very wonderful explanation for the phenomenon of night. They believe, it enables them to sleep. God covers up the dome of the sky with a cover made of leather. The stars are sunlight leaking through the holes. Early human beings had many ingenuous explanation about nature. But behind all of them was the core belief that mankind is very important. 'We' are the centre of the universe and therefore God, the creator takes special care of us. But then came science, the spoilsport. It was only in 1543, when the polish scientist, Nicholas Copernicus

published his book on the Revolution of the celestial spheres in which he argued that we are only one of many planets in our solar system, going around the sun, and not the other way round. This theory created quite a storm in the world.

But winds were changing in favour of science by late 17th century when Isaac Newton, with his theory of gravitation decisively proved Copernicus was right.

Then increasingly powerful telescopes opened up the sky to the astronomers. The telescopes not only worked in the visible range but newer versions have now come

up that covered the whole electromagnetic spectrum: radio waves, infrared, ultraviolet, x-rays, gama rays. With naked eyes, we can see just about three thousand stars but with telescopes, these numbers roset to thousands, then millions and now billions.

Science broke another myth. Our sun far from being an important star is a middle-aged star of a size that was insignificant in front of real giants. The biggest star, VY Canis Majoris, could eat upto 8 billion suns!

As we studied the sky in more and more detail, it was discovered that there ae 200 billion galaxies like ours in the universe. The biggest galaxy, IC 1101 can gobble up 200000 milky ways. But still we had one thought that gave us pride. We were the only intelligent species in the whole universe. Brandon carter, Robert Dicke and some other scientists came up with the anthropomorphic principle. The principal argument is that the universe has been fine tuned so that only we can exist. The factors like age of the universe, the value of the fine structure constant which characterizes the strength of the electromagnetic interactions, the strength of the nuclear forces which hold together the nucleus, are such that it permits formation of commonly found matter and subsequently life as we know it. They have shown that if ever a minor change in these values were to be made, life would not arise. In 1961, Frank Drake, Emeritus professor of Astronomy and Astrophysics at University of California. Sanfer Cruz, USA came out with an equation to estimate the number of extra-terrestrial civilization in Milky Way Galaxy. It is

given below, along with the meaning of the terms.

Number of extra - terrestrial civilization in Milky Way Galaxy

$N = R * f_p * N_e * f_l * f_i * f_c * L$, where

R - average rate of star formation in a galaxy per year (1/ year)

f_p-Fraction of these stars having planets (0.2-0.5)

N_e- average number of planets that can support life out of above number (1-5)

f_l - Fraction of planets which actually develops life (1)

f_i-Fractions of the above number which develops intelligent life (1)

f_c- Fraction of above, technically competent to send detectable signals (0.1-0.2)

L- Length of time the civilization will last to send detectable signals (1,000-100,000,000)

Original estimates showed N is almost equal to 1. One productive outcome of this equation was that, a programme called SETI (Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence) was started in 1985 in USA. In this programme, using radio telescopes all over the world, scientists have been listening for any intelligent signal from space. But unfortunately till date, no conclusive evidence of intelligent life has been found.

In the coming decades, science may be successful in getting such data. We may find that there are intelligent species like us or, what will be worse, more intelligent than us, somewhere out there. If so, that will be the final veil in our cotton; we will become lesser beings of the universe.

Mr and Mrs Philips along with their son Edmond Philips lived happily. Mr Philips was a marine engineer and Mrs Philips was a teacher. They paid the fees for Edmond every month at the school. Mrs Philips earns 2 times the fees of Edmond and Mr Philips earns 3 times the fees of Edmond, totally adding to 30,000 rupees per month.

One day Mrs Philips was correcting the answer papers in the class. Inadvertently she treated a correct answer as wrong and checked her bundle of answer books. In that class of 40 students, many got low marks. Some disliked it and 8 children left the school. The Principal called Mrs Philips and said, "Whatever percentage of children left the school, a proportionate percentage of money will be deducted from your salary." As a fall out of this, they found great difficulty in paying the fees of Edmond and look after their needs. Mr Philips used to go to sea only for 9 days and he worked only on these days in a month. Now he decided to work more from the next day to pay Edmond's fees. Find the number of days Mr Philips has to do more work to balance their income and expenditure.

ANSWER:

Let Edmond's fees be x
Mr Philips earns Rs $3x$
Mrs Philips earns Rs $2x$
Total earning = Rs. 30,000
Rs. $3x + Rs. 2x = Rs. 30,000$
Rs. $5x = Rs. 30,000$
 $x = 30,000 \div 5 = Rs 6,000$
So, Mr Philips earns Rs $(3 \times 6000) = Rs 18,000$
Mrs Philips earns Rs $(2 \times 6000) = Rs 12,000$
No. of students in the class = 40 students
No. of students left = 8 students


Percentage of students left the class = $8/40 \times 100 = 20\%$
20% of Mrs Philips' salary = $20/100 \times 12,000 = 2400$ Rupees
Mrs Philips salary = Rs 12,000 - Rs 2400 = Rs 9600
No. of days Mr Philips did work in a month = 9 days
Mr Philips' salary = Rs 18,000
Number of days Mr Philips has to work more to meet the reduction 18,000 rupees in 9 days means:
1 day = Rs 2,000
 $1/2000 = x/2400$ $1/2000 \times 2400 = x$
 $x = 24 \div 20 = 1.2$ days
So total days he has to work = 9 days + 1.2 days = 10.2 days

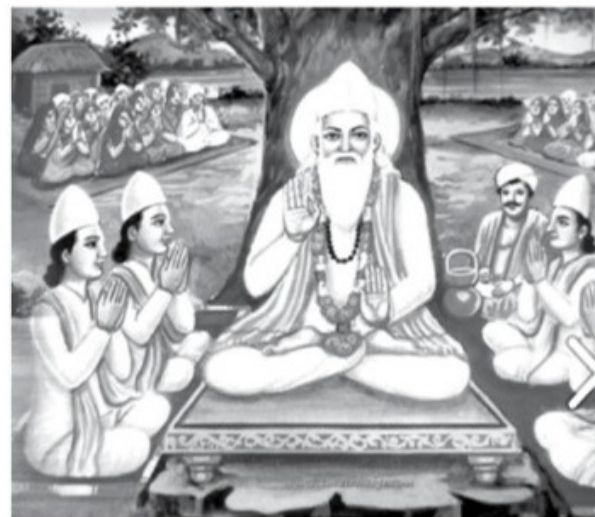

साछियों में उन्होंने अपने समय में प्रचलित लड़कियों और अधविधवाओं का छत्रुण किया है। अपनी कविता के द्वारा कबीर समाज में त्रासो और सुधार लाया चाहते थे। अपनी बापो द्वारा कबीर ने हिन्दू और मुसलमानों में एकत्व स्थापित किया था। कबीर ने अपनी बापो द्वारा बोलचाल को भाषा में, 'जीवन को क्षण भांगुरता', 'गुरु को महिमा' ईश्वर का महत्व', 'मनुष्य को एकता' आदि उनके विचार प्रकट किया है। कबीर ईश्वर को अन और निराकार मानते है। 'प्रेम महिमा', 'गुरु महिमा' 'भूति-पूजा का विरोध', 'आत्म-प संबंध', 'संसार को मथारता', आदि बातों को ने काश्य रचें थे।

The teacher called on a nine year old boy who marched firmly to the blackboard upon which was a list of number a yard long. Standing on tiptoe to reach the top, he arrived at the total with what seemed the speed of light. A thin studious looking boy was told to multiply 5132437201 times 452736502785. He blitzed through the problem, computing the answer - 232364166944374104785 in seventy seconds. The class was one where Trachtenberg System of mathematics taught.

The late Jakob Trachtenberg, founder of mathematical institute in Ziirich, Switzerland, and originator of the startling new system of arithmetic, was of the firm opinion that everyone comes into the world with "Phenomenal Calculation possibilities".

His method is not only speedy but simple. Once one has mastered the rules, calculation becomes as easy as reading a story.

Few rules and illustration are given here.

Multiplication by 11

1. The last number of the multiplicand is put down as the right hand figure of the answer.
2. Each successive number of the multiplicand is added to its neighbour at the right.

3. The first number of the multiplicand becomes the left hand number of the answer.

e.g 721324×11
Answer : 7934564

Multiplication by 12

Double each number in turn and add its neighbour
Eg 0413×12
Answer 4956

Multiplication by 6

To each number add 'half' of the neighbour
Eg 622084×6
Answer 3732504

Note : to each number add half the neighbour, plus 5 if number is odd.

Eg 443052×6
Answer : 2658312

Multiplication by 7

Double the number and add half the neighbour, add 5 if the number is odd.

Eg 04242×7
Answer : 29694
Eg 03412×7
Answer : 23884
