OLD BOYS DAY &ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING REPORT 09 July 2016

#### SPONSORED BY THE 1991 BATCH

### **EVENT REPORT**

1. This years' OBA reunion was conducted on 09 July 2016 with a record turnout of 450 OBs including the sponsoring batch (1991). The various activities that were conducted by the sponsoring batch and other events that were conducted during reunion day are appended in the succeeding paragraphs:

# PROGRAMME ON REUNION DAY 09 July 2016

# 0700h - Alumni arrive at School Campus

2. Alumni started arriving in the Campus as early as 0700h. A total of 362 Alumni (excluding batch of '91) registered at the counter. The sponsoring batch (1991 batch) was in full strength with as many as 100 members with their family members attending. **Rs.74500/- was collected as registration fee.** Thank you, 1991 batch, for attending in such large numbers. This year the maximum attendees were from the 2016 batch (40 OBs) that fetched them the cash award of Rs 5000/- reserved for the batch with maximum attendees (sponsored by the 91 batch).

### 0820h - All OBs of 1991 Batch assemble at the Harshan Pavilion

## 0830h - Arrival of the Chief Guest and Hoisting of OBA Flag

3. **Mr Rajiv Sadanand, IAS (645/75) Additional Chief Secretary – Health, Govt of Kerala** was the Chief Guest. He was received by the Principal Col A Rajiv (2053/90), Administrative Officer Lt Col B Girish Kumar (1928/89) and Vice Principal Lt Cdr Gireesh G, along with the OBA President Cdr Sam T Samuel (Retd) (637/75). Along with the batch of 91 and other Old Boys present, the group paid homage at the Hut of Remembrance – dedicated to the memory of all departed Old Boys. The Chief Guest, in the presence of the School Administration Officers and OBA President, subsequently hoisted the OBA Flag.

## <u>0845h - 1991 batch procession</u>

4. After hoisting of the OBA Flag, the batch of 1991 marched towards the School Foyer under command of **Capt Nazir Ali (IN Retd) (2240/91)**. They along with other OBs present stood audience to the wreath laying and paid respect to the martyrs.

## 0900h- Wreath Laying Ceremony by the Chief Guest

5. The Chief Guest, laid a wreath at the Stupa of Remembrance in memory of those alumni who laid down their lives in the service of the nation. Subsequently, the Chief Guest paid homage to the School Founder Shri VK Krishna Menon in the Foyer, Col NJ Nair AC KC in the North Wing, Capt Harshan AC in the South Wing and to 2/Lt R M Naresh and Maj S Chandran SM in the Central Triangle.

## 0920h - Commemoration Meeting at Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Memorial Auditorium

6. The commemoration meeting started with the Presidential welcome and address. In his address, the OBA President Cdr Sam T Samuel (Retd) (637/75), stressed the need for all the old boys to become part of the association and emphasized the benefits of being a part of this family. This was followed by the distribution of prizes sponsored by the OBA. The Chief Guest, **Mr Rajiv Sadanand, IAS (645/75) Additional Chief Secretary – Health, Govt of Kerala**, gave away the prizes to the cadets who excelled in various subjects in the previous academic year.

## **OBA Lifetime Achievement Awards**

- 7. This year, the OBA introduced the Lifetime Awards for the OBs who excelled in various levels during their illustrious career. The following OBs were awarded this year.
  - (a) <u>Lt Gen Thomas Mathew PVSM\_AVSM (Retd) (6/65)</u> For being one of the first to reach to the rank of Lt Gen, a PSO, MA to France and service to OBA
  - (b) <u>Lt Gen SP Sree Kumar PVSM AVSM (Retd) (38/65)</u> For being one of the first to reach to the rank of Lt Gen, SO in C, U6 in UNOSOM and service to OBA
  - (c) <u>Dr Jacob Mathew PhD (106/65)</u> In the field of science, for numerous awards, 17 publications and 14 Patents to his name.
  - (d) Mr K Babu Gireesh (158/65) The first alumni to join IIT and achievements in the field of Computer Engineering. He has instituted three endowments to the school for the OBA, and abundant financial assistance to the OBA at various stages of OBA since its inception.
  - (e) Mr U Sarath Chandran, IAS (61/66) The first IAS officer from the school, Odisha Cadre IAS officer rose to the level of Development Commissioner cum Additional Chief Secretary. Also served as adviser to World Bank Washington.
  - (f) Mr TK Chandramohanan (64/66) -For having served in different appointments in the OBA and still a member of EC and service to OBA
  - (g) Mr PC Thomas (167/65) For having been elected as a Parliamentarian six times, Minister of State in the Central Government.

## Late Fg Offr MP Anil Kumar Memorial Achiever of the Year Awards

- 8. OBA felicitated the following illustrious alumni for their achievements in **2015-16** with the Late FgOffr MP Anil Kumar Memorial Achiever Awards. The Awards are instituted in memory of MP Anil Kumar (1122/81):
  - (a) <u>Col G Praveen, SM (2292/92)-</u> For being awarded Sena Medal (SM) on 26 Jan 2016 by the President of India.
  - (b) Wg Cdr Suraj Shankar (2291/92) For being awarded Vayusena Medal (VM) on 26 Jan 2016 by the President of India.
  - (c) Mr MS Mohan Nayar (278/72) Technology award for Commercialization of Indigenous Technology from the President of India on 11 May 2016.
  - (d) Mr.James Mathew (1445/84) Senior Partner and Managing Director, Crowe Horwath, UAE (Top Accounting and Professional Services Firm in 130 countries with 752 offices worldwide). Present Secretary General of Indian Business and Professional Council, Dubai (Largest council representing Indian Businessmen and Professional in Dubai under the patronage of Dubai Chamber of Commerce and Industry).
  - (e) <u>Col A Rajiv (2053/90)</u> First SSKZM alumnus to become the Principal of the Sainik School.
  - (f) <u>Lijo Stephen Chacko (2045/90)</u> Ran the 'Head Held High Foundation' as its COO. Over the last two years, raised a total pool of about 250 Change-makers, 100 Catalyts, 30 Coaches and 10 mentors. Selected as 'Fellow' at the Institution of Engineers (India). Published articles on social causes/organisations in the Malayalam online daily Azhimukham. Memoirs written on the climbing of Everest published by DC

Books in Malayalam. Was selected to be the Independent Observer of the Steering Committee (the highest body) meeting of YALI, an initiative set rolling by President Obama in Africa to give suggestions on how to improve their work.

- (g) <u>Rajesh Unni (2002/90)</u> Entrepreneur of the year World Malayalee Council meet held in Singapore. Outstanding leadership award and life time achievement award Singapore maritime association. Outstanding contribution to the maritime community Samudra manthan awards in Mumbai.
- (h) <u>Deepak Nair (2803/97)</u> Recipient of Innovative Biotechnologist Award and Ramalingaswami Fellowship from Department of Biotechnology for his contributions in using cutting edge tools to understand how brain functions.
- (j) <u>Sruthijith KK (3308/99)</u> Launched two US-based digital media publications in India by the age of 30. Launched Quartz India as editor, and was later named editor-inchief of The Huffington Post, when the prestigious US-based digital publication launched in India in 2014. Quartz is a business news publication owned by US-based Atlantic Media.
- (k) <u>Dr Jayesh S Pillai (3296/2001)-</u> As Academician / Designer Appointed as Assistant Professor at the Industrial Design Centre, IIT Bombay. As Filmmaker Film Festival Selections/Awards Gulzar (Short Film 2016, 15'), Selection at Cannes Film Festival, Short Film Corner, May 2016, France, #Addicted (Short Film 2015, 6' 34"), Selection (Focus) at SIGNS Festival 2015, Kochi, Kerala, Somewhere Far (Short Film, 2014, 5' 2") Selection, 7th Int. Documentary and Short Film Festival of Kerala 2014, Official Selection at 4th Gujarat International Film Festival of India 2014.

Subsequently, in his address, **Mr Rajeev Sadanand, IAS (645/75)** urged the students of Sainik School Kazhakoottam to join the Armed Forces where there are a large number of opportunities, and also informed the young cadets of SSK that, though the world has got lots of opportunities, Armed Forces is the most lucrative career in front of them. He also urged the cadets to consider joining the Civil services after leaving the school.
- 12. Cdr Sam T Samuel (Retd) (637/75), President, OBASSKZM thanked the chief guest and all the Cadets, Staff and Alumni for their active participation in all the events of this year's OB day. Thereafter, all members of staff, cadets and alumni moved for tea arranged outside the auditorium at the Maj Satish Chandran SM Gallery.

## **School Team Humbles OBA Teams Again**

13. The OBA teams were a mismatch in all the matches this year as they lost all of them (Cricket, Volleyball and Football) to the School teams. In Basketball the school team outclassed the masters / veterans in all department whereas in cricket and football, as expected the fitness level of the OBA teams were found wanting. The Prizes were distributed by Captain Louis George Meprath (Retd) (642 / 1972) in the evening post conclusion of all matches. This was followed by tea.

# **Dedication of Sanjay KD Memorial Organic Farming Project**

14. The Pilot Project is dedicated to the memory of Sanjay KD (2160/91) who passed away in 2003. The initiative is headed by project convener, Dr Abhiram CS (2141/91). Project Sanjay commenced on 23 April 2016, situated right next to the Cadet's Mess to draw attention of the cadets and staff to the possibilities of an organic farming initiative in the school campus.

The vegetables planted include bitter gourd, snake gourd, cowpea, pumpkin, ash-gourd, cucumber, green chilly, capsicum, red amaranth, ladies finger, brinjal, papaya, and curry leaves. The site was cleaned up, plowed and climber supports were set up before the planting was done. A new pipeline to the site from the School Mess ensured abundant water supply. 20 volunteer cadets assist in the project learning the ideals of sustainable organic farming.

The Pilot Project was dedicated by Sandeep KD, Sanjay's brother, in the presence of the OBA President Cdr Sam T Samuel (Retd) (637/75), Principal Col A Rajiv (2053/90), Administrative Officer Lt Col B Girish Kumar (1928/89) and Vice Principal Lt Cdr Gireesh G, teachers, cadets and Old Boys.
