# PROGRAMME ON REUNION DAY 23 June 2018

## 0700h - Alumni arrive at School Campus

5. Alumni started arriving in the Campus as early as 0700h. A total of 358 alumni (including batch of '93) registered at the counter. The sponsoring batch (1993 batch) was in full strength with as many as 40 members with their family members attending. Rs 1,44,600/was collected as registration fee. # SSKZMOBA ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING MINUTES 1140 h at the Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Memorial Auditorium on 23 June 2018

## Silent Prayer (1 Min) in memory of dear departed.

1. The General Body meeting started by observing one-minute silence in memory of our dear departed Alumni, Cadets and Staff. 122 alumni attended the AGBM.

## Welcome Address by Jt Sec, SSKZM OBA

2. Dr Habeeb Mohammed Jt Sec, SSKZM OBA welcomed our new Patron Col V K S RAWAT and the new OBA in Charge & Ex Officio Member Sri Arun Kumar MS, Senior Master SSKZM to the meeting along with the members. During the year, in addition to 4 Obs, 85 cadets of 2018 batch joined SSKZM OBA as life members.

Four EC meetings were held during the year: 1<sup>st</sup> on 09 Aug 2017 (14/20), 2<sup>nd</sup> on 28 Oct 2017 (08/20), 3<sup>rd</sup> on 20 Jan 2018 (09/20) and 4<sup>th</sup> on 21 Apr 2018 (10/20) to discuss and decide on SOP for Liaison of SSKZMOBA with SSKZM, release of School Bulletin 'Renaissance', reviewed Endowments by Individuals and Batches for Awards to Cadets, approved 1993 Batch projects, Capt Paul Bastine Memorial Pavilion, finalized 49th OBA REUNION program and agreed to discuss further on Golden Jubilee Program. Increasing number of Old Boys participated in school Annual Day, Sports Day and POP Functions. 2 EC Members were nominated and Awards Committee formed.

9<sup>th</sup> Ed of Capt R Harshan AC Memorial Inter-School Basketball Championship was held from 25-27 Oct 2017, where in 9 Teams participated. 10 Teams participated in the 6<sup>th</sup> Ed of Col NJ Nair AC, KC Memorial Inter School Quiz/Debate Competition. OBA had earmarked Rs.99,000/- as assistance. Rs 65,000/- was released as advance from the OBA general fund to conduct 1<sup>St</sup> Ed of Shri NBN Memorial Teachers Enrichment Program on 18 November 2017. 60 Teachers & 5 Speakers made the event memorable. Aid for 15 Cadets from SSF includes Direct Assistance from OBA: 60,000/-, Young Brigades Group contributed 53,000/- and on an emergency, direct aid was provided for 2 with concurrence of OBA

President made an appeal to the fraternity to contribute liberally towards NBN Memorial Initiatives, Student Scholarship Fund & Golden Jubilee Celebrations

During the above period, we were able to close Federal Bank SB Account, Aadhaar number was incorporated in the new format of our Membership form. Rs 5 Lakhs was released as medical relief to Dr. B Mohana Chandran (/1972), additional aid of Rs 3 Lakhs to Renjith BV (/2002) to continue with his treatment.

On behalf of the AGBM, he thanked Col. A Rajiv (2053/90), ex Principal SSKZM for all the good work done to our Alma mater. He also thanked Sri K Rajendran, Senior Master (retd.), SSKZM & OBA in-Charge & Ex Officio member

### **Brief Introduction by OBA President**

3. Cdr Sam T Samuel (Retd) (637/75) thanked all Obs, especially the chief guest, the Principal Col VKS Rawat and the staff of SSKZM for making the 49th reunion a huge success. He, on behalf of all the OB's, also thanked the batch of '93 for successfully organizing the reunion and for the efforts to execute all the projects during the last one year.

He stressed on the relevance of fruitful discussion during the AGBM to arrive at important decisions. Later projected OBAs' short term plan & mid term perspective of an

organization that is 50years young. He emphasized that we need to look beyond our current structure that include annual reunion and minimal activities for the alumni, cadets and school.

Major mid term activities recommended for alumni includes recognition & periodic support to 17 active chapters spread worldwide. Regular Networking structure & constructive competition between chapters, batch wise Group Medical insurance/ death coverage, Career guidance especially from senior serving OBS for organised motivational trips/talks etc. Activities suggested for school include Outbound training for teachers, reemployment and career assistance to Teachers/ Non Teaching staff on retirement. For cadets, senior serving OBS would help organise motivational trips to NDA / NA etc and facilitate a Trip to NDA /NA for UPSC qualified cadets along with their parents, for better conversion of joining NDA.

Celebrity based fund raising event in addition to contribution of Rs 1,00,000/- from each batch was proposed and accepted by the AGBM towards GJ expense. Specific Batch/Chapter sponsoring an activity like NBNMTEP by Bangaluru, NDA visit by Pune/Mumbai and NA visit byKochi / Malabar etc were also accepted. It was also agreed that Col N J Nair Memorial Inter School Quiz Competition and Capt Harshan Memorial Inter School Basketball Tournament would be taken to an enhanced level.

OBA also intends to initiate annual subscription from members (say Rs.50\*12 months=Rs.600) and activity based voluntary contribution like SSF, NBNMTEP. A platform would be created for resourceful Obs to register for voluntary assistance to OB activities by sending a mail to admin@sskzmoba.org

Attempt will be made to release OBA GJ Coffee Table Book with the support of sponsors. Data would be assimilated by 1994 Batch and Ceejo Thomas (1983/91) to publish GJ OBA Directory (hard copy). Chapter Visits, Insurance options, placement agencies for young alumni would provide a new direction
