**Inception Location:** Sainik School Kozhakootam was established on 20 Jan 1962 in the military barracks of Pangode, Thiruvananthapuram. The Chief Minister of Kerala, Late Pamm Thanu Pillai chose the location for the school 3 Km away from Thiruvananthapuram on NH 47 near Kozhakootam. The sprawling campus of 225 acres nestled between the slender strands of the Western Ghats and the Arabian Sea, situated on a hilllock blessed with vegetation, is an ideal location for a military-based residential institution. The foundation stone of Sainik School, Kozhakootam was laid by Late VK Krishna Menon, Minister of Defence, Govt of India on 05 Feb 1962. The founder Principal was Lt Col HK Somaiah, Headmaster Sqn Ldr Habo Lal and the Registrar was Capt TVS Nair. During the 52 years of its existence, the school has been providing yeoman service as a feeder institution to NDA and INA and also making public school education accessible to the common man.

**Alumni:** Over 9200 students have passed out of the portals of this School and have made their mark in various walks of life. It is a matter of pride that approximately 920 Kozhakootamites have joined the Armed Forces. Old Boys Association of Sainik School Kozhakootam was established in 1969. The chief guest has been adequately introduced to the audience by our Administrative Officer and so I do not wish to duplicate the same. Suffice to say, we are indeed fortunate and honoured to have such an illustrious officer like his goodness as the Chief Guest for the 54<sup>th</sup> Annual Day 2015. Sir, I am sure that your benign presence on this occasion will be a great source of motivation for all of us.

On this befitting occasion I shall now present before you the wide spectrum of activities and events carried out in the School during the current academic session 2015-16.

Sainik School Kazhakootam is one of the 25 Sainik Schools in the country, which was established in 1962. It has come a long way since its inception in making a significant mark as an educational institution of high repute aimed at overall development of students with a military bias in our beloved state of Kerala.

Apart from our basic aim of preparing the boys for entry into the National Defence Academy/ Naval Academy and the OTA, the training imparted in this school shape the students socially and create in them a know how to approach life meaningfully in order to emerge as responsible citizens of India and leaders in different walks of life.

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**New Admissions**

After the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination and selection procedure thereafter, 130 cadets were admitted to the school in the beginning of the current session, 120 in Class VI and 10 in Class IX. The present school strength is 663 including 629 Boarders and 34 Day Scholars.

**Academics**

Despite a very busy schedule of various regular co-curricular and extracurricular activities, Academics continue to be one of our prime concern. As in the past, this year too our academic achievements have been good with 100% pass in Class X and class XII CBSE Board Exam held in March 2014. Of the 97 cadets who appeared in class X, 04 cadets secured 10 CGPA, 77 cadets secured above 7.5 CGPA and the remaining 16 cadets secured CGPA 6 to 7.0. 04 cadets were awarded merit certificate by CBSE for securing AI for all subjects. The overall CGPA was 8.9.

In class XII, of the 81 cadets who ap-

peared, 50 secured distinctions and the remaining 31 secured first division. The top scorers in class XII among all Sainik Schools, Cdt Akash M Lal and Cdt Mahadev A, who secured 95% marks from this school. Cadet Nitin PM received CBSE merit card.

I wish to place on record the excellent work done by the Vice Principal, Lt Cdr Girish Gopidas, Senior Master Mr. K Rajendran and his team of teachers to bring up the results to this exalting standards. Sir, you will appreciate it more when we convey to you that this result is a product of purely classroom education and not based on any sort of extra tuitions.

**Sports and Games**

Facilities for playing almost all major games (Football, Hockey, Volleyball, Tennis, Basketball, Cricket and Badminton) and participation in athletic track and field events exist in the School campus. Besides these, the Cadets take up indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess and Caroms. Participation in major sports for all the boys

Our first batch of students joined NDA in 1965 and till date, more than 850 alumni have been awarded the President's Commission in the Armed Forces. Regular NDA preparatory classes are arranged for the boys to prepare them for the UPSC written examination.

8 Cadets appeared in the UPSC Exam for 134 & 135 NDA Courses, 27 cadets qualified the exam and 08 cadets qualified SSR, wherein 06 cadets joined NDA/ Naval Academy. The UPSC written examination for entry into the 136 NDA course was held on 27 Sep 2015. 60 cadets of Class XII appeared in the examination. Results are awaited.

#### Presentations/Talks

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Our cadets participated in many in-

Two of our cadets participated in ISRO Space Quiz organized by ISRO at Thiruvananthapuram on 09 Oct 2015.

#### NCC Activities

Sainik School has an NCC Coy of 960 cadets under the command of the Vice Principal Lt Cdr Girish Gopidas. School Cadet Capt Arman Noyal Mancrene visited Vietnam and Cadet Adarsh Menon visited Sri Lanka as part of the Youth Exchange Programme. Cdt Santhanu J Nair and Cdt Praveen Hari got Chief Minister's Scholarship for NCC cadets and Cdt Sanjay Krishna R of 2014-15 batch received the Best Cadet Award. All cadets of SS Coy NCC participated in the International Yoga Day, at SS Coy NCC on 21 Jun 2015. 93 Cadets from SS Coy NCC participated in Swatch Bharat Abhiyan on 02 Oct 2015 and participated in social service activities in connection with World Environment Day. Senior Division contingent of SS Coy NCC participated in ID parade held at Chandrasekharan Nair Stadium. Certificate Exam for the year 2015-16 was conducted, 112 cadets for 'A' Certificate, 96 cadets for 'B' Certificate. Certificates were awarded to all the cadets.

#### Motivational Tours / Visits

In order to break the monotony of routine life at school and to widen the imagination of the cadets, we organise motivational tours to various Defence/ Historically important places of interest for all classes. 118

cadets of class VI went on an Educational Tour in and around Trivandrum on 03 Oct 15. Cadets visited Planetarium, Science and Technology Museum, Zoo, Kovilam, Vizhinjam and Veli. A Team of 109 cadets from classes VII visited Kanyakumari, Baywatch Water Theme park and other places of interest on 07 Oct 15. A team of 30 meritorious cadets from classes IX & X along with a teacher and an NCO from SS Coy NCC proceeded on a forward area tour to 4 Corps 2, Assam & Arunachal Pradesh from 24 May to 07 Jun 2015. During the tour, they chance to meet some of our very senior high ranking old boys.

#### Old Boys' Association

Lt Gen Sarath Chand, AVSM, VSM, the first Old Boy and the first Keralite to become an Army Cdr, was the chief guest for the functions.

#### Administration

Considerable delay had occurred due to an unforeseen strike by the PWD contractors during summer vacations this year. Works which were to be carried out during summer vacation, despite our best efforts got delayed. However, all efforts were made to ensure that major repair and maintenance work of classrooms, dormitories, mess etc were carried out. Works were also undertaken by the PWD to maintain training facilities and to improve the living conditions of the cadets and staff members. The notable works carried out or ongoing are-

- (a) Construction of a new overhead tank, Additional septic tank, new toilet block, Storage water tank in six dormitories etc, the work is being done by PWD and nearing its completion.
- (b) Repair and renovation of main underground water reservoir.
- (c) Change of remaining roof and false ceiling of 3 wings of 2 dormitories 10 & 11.
- Work done/ being done from MoD Grant.
- (a) Construction of new NDA block.
- (b) Change of two roofs and two towers of academic block.



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#### Total Land Survey

Site survey of the entire land pertaining to the school using total station survey was conducted by a team of surveyors deputed by the PWD Kerala. The long pending issue thus was finally resolved and the school now is a step closer to the 'Memorandum of Association' being signed with the state Govt.

#### Audit

The Local Audit Officer from LAO Pangode audited the school stores/ cash accounts twice in this academic year. No serious audit objections were reported.

#### BOG Meeting

Sainik Schools Society had conducted its Board of Governors Meeting on 15 Jul 2015 after a long gap of 20 years. Very vital decisions were taken by the BoG which will help the schools to be run in a better manner. Our honourable chief guest today, was a principal contributor in the said conference.

#### Annual Inspection

Annual inspection of the school after a long 5 year gap was carried out by Capt (IN) G Rambabu, Inspecting Officer, Sainik Schools Society, MoD, New Delhi. The administration has been successful in implementing the long pending sixth pay commission recommendations related to PB-1 and MACP. Towards this, adversely affected staff who were under metric were also sent on multi skill/skill augmentation training.

#### Additional Edge obtained from State Govt

Active liaison with Socy Sports, Govt of Kerala and other officials from Aug 2015 onwards has resulted in release of equipment from National Games Village to the tune of Rs 65 Lacs. This is the first time such an allotment is being made. They include

- (a) 300 Blank Beds
- (b) 700 mattresses and pillows
- (c) 325 cupboards
- (d) 36-40 inches LCD TVs,
- (e) Heavy duty pumps
- (f) 06 Washing Machines
- (g) 06 Refrigerators



He replied in the affirmative, saying not one, but that we were about to be parents to 600+... Though I read them to and fro messages in his whatsapp group, on all print and proper wives do with their husband's groups and messages, it didn't strike me as anything more than a chancery of loose talk between friends. That he meant business, I realised after about 06 months of our stay at 'The Kashak House', his appointment house at School.



The new class VI had joined school in June. Most of the talk at home then revolved around their antics, smart acts, homesickness etc all. The highlight being one smart alec decluring to the Principal that he would cry only for three days and then stop hoping to become the principal of this school one day as he was told that their present Principal had done just that 32 years ago. How close, I was to realise soon when one fine day, all hell broke loose with a phone call to declare a missing seventeenth child. Though my husband was on leave, he immediately left for office and without realising what I was upto, my feet carried me to the Puja room. I think that was when the reality and enormity of the responsibility sank in me for the first time. After three hours, I went once again to the Puja room to thank all my deities, since by then, the well oiled system at school could locate the child who was hiding in the thickets within the premises, ostensibly scared of an upcoming cross country event.

It then became a routine affair, my special visits to the puja rooms, though thankfully, not for reasons stated earlier. Class XII moving for their first UPSC written, external practicals of that class, Board exams for class X, where I tried my level best to drive reason into the head of my stubborn husband to let the school have internal boards and not external (well, of course, he didn't budge, doubting my concern to be aimed at just one child, our daughter, and not the entire gang of 1139), Board exams of class XII and so on. The heightened levels of palpable tension evident just before the declaration of each result of the above, in itself stood testimony to the level these children had been settled in my psyche. And the pleasure of success, well, words fail me. It was such a happy tiding hearing the enviable results these children scored despite dedicating less than half the time clocked by children outside for academics. I have no reason to disagree, when my husband

The remaining day, I walked around with a feeling of a proud mother who had a chance of making her children happy. Well, as another year dawns, the cycle is set to repeat. Already this year's Fresher's day is over and done with. Beaming faces, full of hopeful expectations, absorbing the ambience of this wonderful seat of learning, and in turn transferring their youth, vitality and vibrancy to the campus to keep it ever young! What a beautiful, never ending cycle. I'm reminded of an old evergreen English movie, 'The never ending story'.

So, Gandhari, no one would ever script an epic on mothers like me who nurture a large brood, but nevertheless, the smug satisfaction is reward enough. Hope you too get a re-birth as the first lady in a school like this.

## Education







**16<sup>th</sup>** of October 2015 was perhaps one of the most awaited day in my life. It was on this day that I was to start my journey to Sri Lanka as part of the Youth Exchange Programme of NCC. The selection for YEP was conducted during the Republic day camp at Delhi. After a strenuous procedure, ten cadets from Kerla and Lakshadweep directorate were selected to visit foreign countries. I was lucky enough to be one of the elite lot.

I boarded the train from Trivandrum and reached Delhi two days prior to my original reporting date. My commanding Officer soon followed suit. Although the only thing in my mind at that time was Sri Lanka, I had to conquer my eagerness and wait for ten days in the RD camp at Delhi.

On 24<sup>th</sup> of October everyone in our group was present at the YEP block at RD camp. Since ours was a small delegation we had only six

cadets altogether, SDO Anitha Bhat, SDO Bodhi Dushantra Raj, SDO Sakshi, SDO Harish Rao, SDO Rohit Ramesh Upadhyay and myself. We were to be chaperoned by Col. K B Jainraj of the Kumaon Regiment. It fills my heart with joy unspeakable to tell you at this point of time that Col. K B Jainraj is an old boy of our school who passed out of our institution in 1978 as the HC of Patel then Nehru. While in Delhi, we practised for the presentation that we had to give in Sri Lanka. Many days were spent between the six of us laughing, playing, enjoying and at times partying. During this time one day we spent for Delhi Darshan. Jainraj sir was always with us whenever time permitted and he gave us his full support in everything that we did. Before we departed for Sri Lanka, we were issued our uniforms, combats, Jodhpuri and our track suits.

Finally on 31<sup>st</sup> of October the D-day arrived. Garbed in our track suits with 'INDIA' written on our backs, the flag on our chest, the pride that we felt is undefinable. Only someone who had experienced it could understand it. Eyes used to follow us from our camp to the Indira Gandhi Airport and inside the Airport, the envy of the people were clear in their eyes. The day was unforgettable for all of us. We boarded our flight and touched down in the Bandaranaike International Airport at 1800hrs. We were given a formal welcome and reception by the NCC officials, a Colonel and a representative from the Indian High Commission. We were taken to the NCC Officers' mess. After a sumptuous dinner, we hit our beds with dreams of a great day ahead.

The next morning saw us all visiting the Colombo Zoological park. It was so big that even after spending five hours there, barely stopping, we were informed that we had not covered even half the zoof! In the evening we had a cultural night with programmes from the Sri Lankan cadets as well as our own. Their Director General NCC was a great personality who loved his own voice and never failed to amaze us with his beautiful singing.

Next day we were ushered around the city of Colombo and were left free for shopping. While it may please us to know that one Indian Rupee is valued at 1.73 Sri Lankan rupees, a shoe costs 8000

SL Rupees and a Sam - 120000V. We quickly figured out that the money we had would not be sufficient.

The following day held store for us a variety of dishes. Foremost of them all was probably the visit to Temple of Tooth Relic at Kandy. It is at this place where Lord Buddha's teeth are believed to be preserved. Unfortunately we couldn't see it as it is taken out only once in five years. The entire temple is preserved in its original glory. Nothing touched to safeguard the purity of the temple. The same day by night fall we reached the NCC training Academy at Rantembe.

The days ahead were filled with a varied spectrum of events. The visits to historical places, dams, lakes, waterfalls, shopping, the Sri Lankans never made us feel bored. It was perhaps the best days of our time. A day of our activities had been set aside for Advanced Leadership classes. Invariably the name may sound a bit boring but the classes taken by Lt Col. I W Kramenage were the best motivational classes ever attended by any of us. We never noticed the passage of time and were amazed to realize that we had spent almost four hours in his class. The class instilled in us a sense of team spirit, faith in each other, sportsmanship - in short all the virtues needed

Their hospitality, cleanliness, social discipline, traffic sense, education, everything about them will forever remain in my heart of hearts. At this point I feel that I should thank Capt. Ali our Liaison Officer and Lt. Wasantha Kumar for their continuous support and help while we were in Sri Lanka. It was probably because of them that we were able to enjoy as much as we could. Next morning, we went to see various infantry guns and artillery tanks. We also fired 0.62 mm INSAS rifle. In the evening, we headed for Chilipam monastery. Perched on the hill top, the monastery...



**25<sup>th</sup>** May 2015 was the day when 30 of our friends started our journey to the peaks of North-Eastern States. Nearly 80 clock in the night, the train started from Kochuvelli railway station. That night, the fortune was on our side as monsoon rain cooled the radiating train but the next two days were baked. At night, we slept in sleeping bags and listened to sound of clattering river - It was a thrilling experience. But getting up in the morning was a bit difficult as the sun rises here at 4 O'clock.

Next morning, we went to see various infantry guns and artillery tanks. We also fired 0.62 mm INSAS rifle. In the evening, we headed for Chilipam monastery. Perched on the hill top, the monastery and its interior depicts the Buddhist culture. We were amazed by its art work. At night we slept in the sleeping bag. Next day early morning we left for Tawang.

As we moved upward to Tawang, it was ice cold. In fact, we were drowned in fogs, mists and clouds. We felt the pressure variation in our ear. On the way, we visited Tawant Jawant Garh. The heroic deeds of Jawan Singh started us. He

single handedly fought the Chinese for three long days during sino-India war. We were bambooed when we went inside bunkers, kitchens and signal room of Jaisewar Gash. Creeping through the mosaistans and foggy hills we reached Tawang.

From Tawang, we began our journey to Bumla Border. It was raining. At 12 noon we reached Bumla. There was no sign of weather turning on our side. The temperature was as low as 8°C. We even played with snowballs. But the most fascinating fact is that we infringed into Chinese territory! Some of us even smuggled stones also. We were briefed in the conference room how flag officer meeting took place. On returning to Tawang, we were briefed about the functioning of Ilford Gun.

On June 2, we visited Tawang Monastery - second largest monastery in the world. It was here that Dalai Lama came and stayed for sometime after escaping from Tibet. Situated near to the monastery is Tawang war memorial. The saga of soldiers who made supreme sacrifice were narrated here in the light and sound show. The following day, we visited Jong waterfall and Madhuki lake - where the sizzling song of Bollywood movie 'KYSQA' was shot and descended back to Tenzing.

On June 4, we left Tenga and reached Tezpur. There, we visited Air Force station and saw sukhos -30 taking off and landing. We also had first hand experience of Sukhoi stimulator. In the evening, we had tea party with GOC 4<sup>th</sup> corps, Lt. Gen. Sarath Chand, the man behind this wonderful tour. We thank him from bottom of our hearts. From Tezpur, we came to Guwahati and visited Guwahati Airforce station. At the Airforce station we were taken to cockpit of Avro transport aircraft and MiG-17 helicopter; we also visited the Kamakhya Temple.

On 6<sup>th</sup> June early morning we boarded the Guwahati - Trivandrum express with heavy hearts. All in all, it was a tour which we will cherish.






## Annual Day 2015/2016


