



NBN Tributes by OBs

The One and Only NBN



I went to meet NBN in Bangalore last year to offer my condolences after his wife passed away. As usual, he was very happy to see me. We caught up with things happening around during the last couple of years. On my way back home, I was thinking about something he said - "sorrow shared is sorrow divided". Simple but quite profound.

My earliest memory of NBN goes back to Pangode days. It was my third day in school. Dressed in white and white, he was ringing the bell in front of Duty master's room, in the red house building, near the MI room, for us to line up to go for the assembly. I hardly knew who he was. Few days later, he would walk into our classroom and introduce himself as our Chemistry teacher. Those days, we had an hour a day devoted to science and during that hour, physics, chemistry and biology classes would take turns.

Our batch got a little carried away with the Chemistry lab. Bunsen burners were new, Chemicals were neatly stacked in new bottles, nice and clean pipettes were placed in a corner. We looked forward to a full afternoon of fun. Some of us went overboard. I still remember him explaining how to determine the taste of a chemical – dilute it so that it does not burn the mouth, how to sense the smell of a chemical – hold it away from your nose and blow the air over the chemical with the other hand to your nose, how to heat the contents of a test tube – hold it the just above the blue flame where maximum heat is dissipated. In the lab, he gave us enough freedom to experiment our curiosity while ensuring the limits are not crossed. He always explained a concept and the scientific rationale behind it, in a simple and easy to understand way.

His enthusiasm to teach did not stop with Chemistry. Once, when he was supervising our evening studies in new Blue house, one of us had problem with an English word. He showed us how to use the oxford dictionary and to my surprise, I realized the dictionary contained more than just meanings of words. He told us how to take a bath. Apply soap to the body and wait for few minutes for the soap to break the bond between the dirt and body before washing the dirt off. Once in a class, I was caught using word VD for vapor density and he explained to the class what VD commonly meant, how venereal diseases are caused and cured. – quiet an enlightening experience for all of us.

The best advice he gave us, I would say, was about the "fear of studying". He told us that studying is nothing but "repetition". One grasps 50% material first time when another 30% next time read, and rest the third time. I followed this advice all my life and I found myself free of any fear to learn however difficult the topic seemed, right from philosophy to science. I passed on this advice to my children and many youngsters I came across and most of them did appreciate it.

He was very committed to our school and took pride in our successes and happiness. He shared our sorrows too. He shared his knowledge and experiences with all of us so that we could learn from them to make our lives better, He was a true educator, guide and mentor. We were all very fortunate to have him as our teacher. May his soul rest in peace.

In 1964 there was an inter house debate and NBN sir was to coord and guide the students. I still remember that there were six participants for and six against the motion on "Foreign Mania". He dictated verbatim the complete script to all 12 of us . just imagine his depth of knowledge and command over English language. If I recall, NJ Nair and RajRam were also a part of this debate.

Before the launch of info era, it was Always a treat to write and receive letters to NBN. Many of us still treasure the choice of his golden words. The Englishmen would have never imagined the use of their language to express so much. I visited school first time in 1984 after I left school. His memory was amazing and the way he introduced me to the class, I thought even I did not know so much about myself. NBN was an enigma and a phenomenon. People like him rarely pass this globe. Generations to come will wonder that a teacher like this ever existed. I am reminded of a few lines "lives of great men all remind us that we can make our lives sublime and departing leave behind us footprints on the sands of time".

Blast from the Past

2/LT Radha Mohan Naresh

GALLANT OLD BOY

Roll No. 112, Radha Mohan Naresh joined the school in 1962 and passed out in 1967 to join the 39th NDA Course. While at school he was known for his inmaculate behaviour and conduct. He was House Captain of Shivaji House. Radha Mohan Naresh was the first alumnus to lay down his life in action. 1967 batch instituted an endowment and trophy in his memory to be awarded to the Best House Captain each year.

2/LT Radha Mohan Naresh was commissioned on 30 Nov 1971 from IMA, Dehradun into 9 JAT. 'OP

CACTUS LILLY', the 1971 operations, had already commenced and 9 JAT was inducted into the battle zone from Kheruh (16 miles from Srinagar) to Jindrah (45 km from Udhampur) along with 7 KUMAON and 5/8 GR as part of 68 Inf Bde commanded by Brig R T Morlin AVSM. As per initial plans the formation was being trained for offensive operations across the Line of Control. However with Pakistan having launched a major offensive in 191 Inf Bde Sector, 9 JAT was

inducted into Champ Sector to evict the enemy.

2/LT Radha Mohan Naresh was the Platoon Cdr of No 4 PT of B Coy Which_was commanded by Maj H S Grewal and was asked to guard the Raipur crossing across Manawar Tawi on Champ Sector. On 09 Dec 1971, Pakistan Army launched a determined effort to breach defences of B Coy deployed at Raipur crossing and of 'C' Coy deployed at Darh crossing with its armour, artillery and upto a brigade strength of Infantry. The determined JATs however repulsed any advance and beat back the attack. On 10 Dec 1971 the Pakistanis started concentrating across Raipur crossing for a fresh assault. At 0600hrs



B Coy at Raipur crossing was attacked by a battalion supported by an armoured squadron.

In the meanwhile 10 GARH RIF Coy on the left of Raipur crossing was attacked and pushed back. At this crucial stage B Coy also lost support of 'C' coy of 9 JAT which was deployed at Darh crossing to the right. No 4 Platoon commanded by 2/Lt Radha Mohan Naresh deployed in the forward location of Raipur crossing was under heavy enemy artillery and armour fire. The Platoon beat back three determined assaults by Pakistanis and were holding the advance of

a force many times its size. At that juncture 2/ LT Radha Mohan was informed that the Coy Cdr Maj H S Grewal had died fighting the Pakistanis. 2/LT Radha Mohan Naresh assumed the charge of Coy Cdr and refused to withdraw despite having been surrounded from all sides. The Coy held the Pakistani advance till own reinforcements arrived in the sector and halted Pakistani advance. In doing so 2/Lt Radha Mohan Naresh fought gallantly and ruthlessly till his last round in the chamber. He died a hero the same day on the banks of Munawar Tawi with the battle cry of 'Jai Hanuman Jai Bhagwan' on his lips.



KAZAKS - 92 PROJECTS!

(a brief of initiatives taken by the sponsoring batch during the year 2016-17)

• H_{92} 0 - Clean safe drinking water for the cadets.

This is one of the marquee projects of the 92 batch which aimed at providing clean, safe drinking water to all the cadets in the school. The batch were inspired by several similar projects done in North India and Africa by NGO's and the core committee identified this as a "key need" area for the cadets after discussion with the school authorities.

Water purifiers with storage mechanism that has a collection capacity of 100 litres were installed in all 11dormitories. The batch also identified the same need for SSKZM LP School and went ahead installing 1 additional unit in the LP school as well.

•The Kazhak Agro Farm - Sustainable development for the future

Another marquee project of the 92 batch. Once the safe drinking water project took off, the core committee, in discussion with the school authorities, thought of dreaming big; i.e., to provide locally grown, farm fresh, uncontaminated vegetables and fruits for the cadets. A humongous amount of work has been ploughed into this project by Kazhaks 92 which has been personally supervised by a multi award winning state agricultural officer from the batch. With this project, the batch's endeavour is to provide the cadets, clean and safe locally grown fruits and vegetables.

•The "Dhwani" music club renovation.

The 92 batch identified that lack of a thriving, well stocked music club was an unmet need of the school and that the school music club was in urgent need of renovations. This was voiced by the teachers and the cadets too and the committee once again swung into action. Instruments were mobilised, cabinets were ordered and wall papers were procured to give the music club a total and complete revamp and the results are there for all to see and enjoy. The OBA hope that the presence of a fully functioning music club would give the cadets another avenue to hone their artistic skills, in conjunction with help and guidance from the music teachers and the school.


•Ignite sessions
