On this solemn occasion of the 51st Annual Day Celebration of our School we are honoured to have Shri. K. Jose Dinesh, IAS amidst us. I am extremely grateful to him for having graciously accepted our invitation despite of his hectic schedule.

So, I am sure that your benign presence on this occasion will be a great source of motivation to all of us.

On this fulfilling occasion that now present before you a wide spectrum of activities and events carried out in the School during the current academic session 2012-13.

St. John's School Kuthalam is one of the 24 St. John's Schools in the country and it was established with a number of 100 cadets started at Military Station Pappadi in 1942. It has come a long way since its inception in making a significant mark as an educational institution of high repute in our state of Kerala. Apart from our basic aim of preparing the boys for entry into the National



Defence Academy, the training engaged in this school shapes the students socially and instils a meaningful approach to their life in general in order to emerge as responsible citizens of India and leaders in different walks of life.

New Admissions

After the 40 India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination in last January and selection procedure thereafter, 86 cadets were admitted to the school in the beginning of the current session. 76 in Class V and 10 in Class II. The present enrolment strength as on today is 441 including 411 students and 30 Day Scholars.

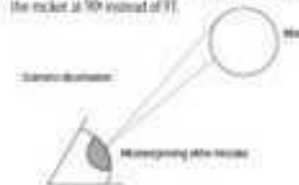

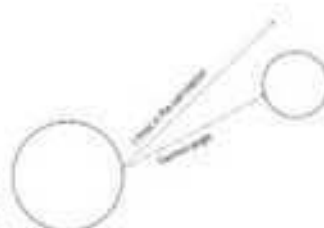
This is the secret agent which spies on everyone. We need this agent in many or every way in our lives. We don't even call it but it comes for our help. That's the quality of agent MM.

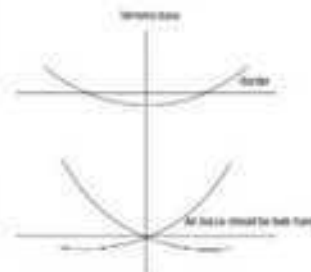
Even if the mistake had been of 0.1 degree, then the rocket wouldn't reach the moon, the rocket would miss it and go elsewhere.

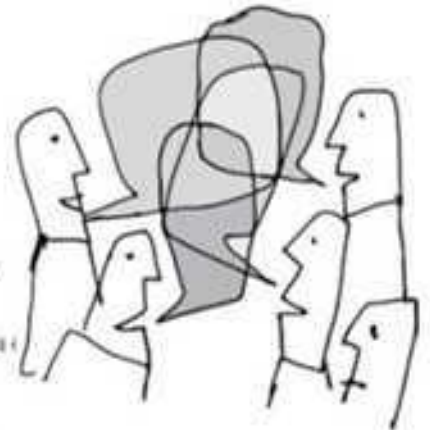

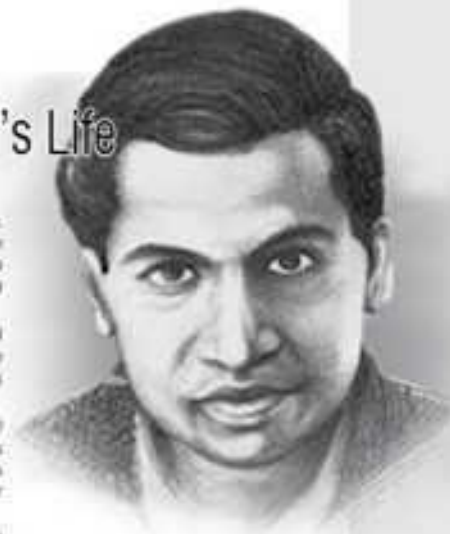

Effect of numbers in Ramanujam's Life



Ramanujan was born on 22nd Dec 1887. He was a great mathematician. Though he lived only for a very short span his contributions to the world in the field of Maths were very high. He died at a young age of 33 in 1920. So, I have a better way to honour the great mathematician whose 125th birth anniversary fell on Dec 22nd 2012 with some number tricks.

Ramanujan's birthday is very special. How? Ramanujan's date of birth, 22/12/1887, happens to be the 12960th prime number where 12960 = $2^4 \times 3^4 \times 5 \times 7$. These four prime factors add up to 357. Coincidentally Ramanujan's birthday 22 December was the 357th day of 2012.

Ramanujan's birthday is numerically connected to Euler's number. How? Ramanujan's birthday 22/12/1887 can be constructed using the first ten digits of Euler's number without using any arithmetic. The first ten digits of Euler's number are 2.718281828. Go ahead and try it. Place each pair of the four 8 digits on top of each other.

Ramanujan's birthday 22 December is also connected to the first 2 digits of pi. How? Go ahead and find the sum of the squares of number 22 and 12 which represents 22nd December. What comes out 314.

The prime factors of 1929 also lead to Ramanujan's year of death. How? Primes 7 and 13 add up to 20 and 19 and 20 side by side yield 1920, the year Ramanujan died.

There is a numerical connection between Ramanujan's name and death day. Why? One fourth of the product of numbers 132 and 13 (representing Srinivasa Ramanujan) yield 2664. That is, April 26.

A primitive tribe that lives by hunting has held a very wonderful explanation for the phenomenon of night. They believe, it enables them to sleep. Early human beings had many ingenious explanations about nature but behind all of them was the core belief that mankind is very important. We are the centre of the universe and therefore God, the creator takes special care of us. But then came science, the sportsman. It was only in 1543, when the polish scientist, Nicholas Copernicus

published his book on the Revolution of the celestial spheres, in which he argued that we are only one of many planets in our solar system, going around the sun, and not the other way round. His theory created quite a storm in the world.

His words were changing in favour of science by late 17th century when Isaac Newton, with his theory of gravitation decisively proved Copernicus was right.

Then increasingly powerful telescopes opened up the sky to the astronomers. The telescopes not only worked in the visible range but newer versions have now come

up that covered the whole electromagnetic spectrum: radio waves, infrared, ultraviolet, x-rays, gamma rays. With naked eyes, we can see just about three thousand stars but with telescopes, these numbers rise to thousands, then millions and now billions.

Science broke another myth. Our sun far from being an important star is a middle-aged star of a size that was insignificant in face of real giants. The biggest star, VY Canis Majoris, could eat up 10 billion suns!

As we studied the sky in more and more detail, it was discovered that there are 200 billion galaxies like ours in the universe. The biggest galaxy, IC 3101 can gobble up 200000 milky ways. But still we had one thought that goes up pride. We were the only intelligent species in the whole universe. Gordon Carter, Robert Dicke and some other scientists came up with the anthropomorphic principle. The principal argument is that the universe has been fine tuned so that only we can exist. The factors like age of the universe, the value of the fine structure constant which characterizes the strength of the electromagnetic interactions, the strength of the nuclear forces which hold together the nucleus, are such that it permits formation of commonly found matter and subsequently life as we know it. They have shown that if near a minor change in these values were to be made, life would not arise. In 1951, Frank Drake, Emeritus professor of Astronomy and Astrophysics at University of California, San Diego, USA came out with an equation to estimate the number of extra-terrestrial civilization in Milky Way Galaxy. It is

- (given below, along with the meaning of the terms.
- Number of extra-terrestrial civilization in Milky Way Galaxy
 - $N = 2 \times 10^{11} \times 10^6 \times 10^1 \times 10^1$, where
 - 10^6 - average rate of star formation in a galaxy per year (1.5/year)
 - 10^1 - fraction of these stars having planets (0.2-0.5)
 - 10^1 - average number of planets that can support life out of above number (1-5)
 - 10^1 - fraction of planets which actually develops life (1)
 - 10^1 - fraction of the above number which develops intelligent life (1)
 - 10^1 - fraction of above, technically competent to send detectable signals (0.1-0.2)
 - 10^1 - length of time the civilization will last to send detectable signals (1000-100,000,000)

Original estimates showed N is almost equal to 1. One productive outcome of this equation was that, a programme called SETI (Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence) was started in 1980 in USA. In this programme, using radio telescopes all over the world, scientists have been listening for any intelligent signal from space. till unfortunately till date, no conclusive evidence of intelligent life has been found.

In the coming decades, science may be successful in getting such data. We may find that there are intelligent species like us or, what will be worse, more intelligent than us, somewhere out there. If so, that will be the final nail in our culture, we will become lesser beings of the universe.

Professor Trachtenberg
Guru of Mathematics

The teacher called on a nine-year-old boy who marched firmly to the blackboard upon which was a list of number card long. Standing on tiptoe to reach the top, he arched at the top with what seemed the speed of light. A thin stooped-looking boy was told to multiply 142343235 from 4523456789. He solved through the problem, computing the answer -- 223441694374194785 in seventy seconds. The class was one where Trachtenberg System of mathematics taught.

The late Jakob Trachtenberg, founder of mathematical institute in Zurich, Switzerland, and originator of the startling new system of arithmetic, was of the firm opinion that anyone comes into the world with "The mental Calculator possibilities."

His method is not only speedy but simple. Once one has mastered the rules, calculation becomes as easy as reading a story.

Few rules and illustration are given here.

Multiplication by 11

1. The last number of the multiplicand is put down in the right hand figure of the answer.
2. Each successive number of the multiplicand is added to its neighbour at the right.

3. The first number of the multiplicand becomes the left hand number of the answer.

e.g. 77224x11
Answer: 795564

Multiplication by 12

Double each number in turn and add its neighbour.
E.g. 9473x12
Answer: 49656

Multiplication by 4

To each number add half of the neighbour.
E.g. 42084x4
Answer: 57256

- Note: To each number add half the neighbour, plus 1 if number is odd.

E.g. 42087x4
Answer: 26832

Multiplication by 7

Double the number and add half the neighbour; add 1 if the number is odd.
E.g. 8245x7
Answer: 29166
E.g. 8417x7
Answer: 23866

The unconditional support rendered by our Principal and the Registrar helped the team to put the best feet forward.

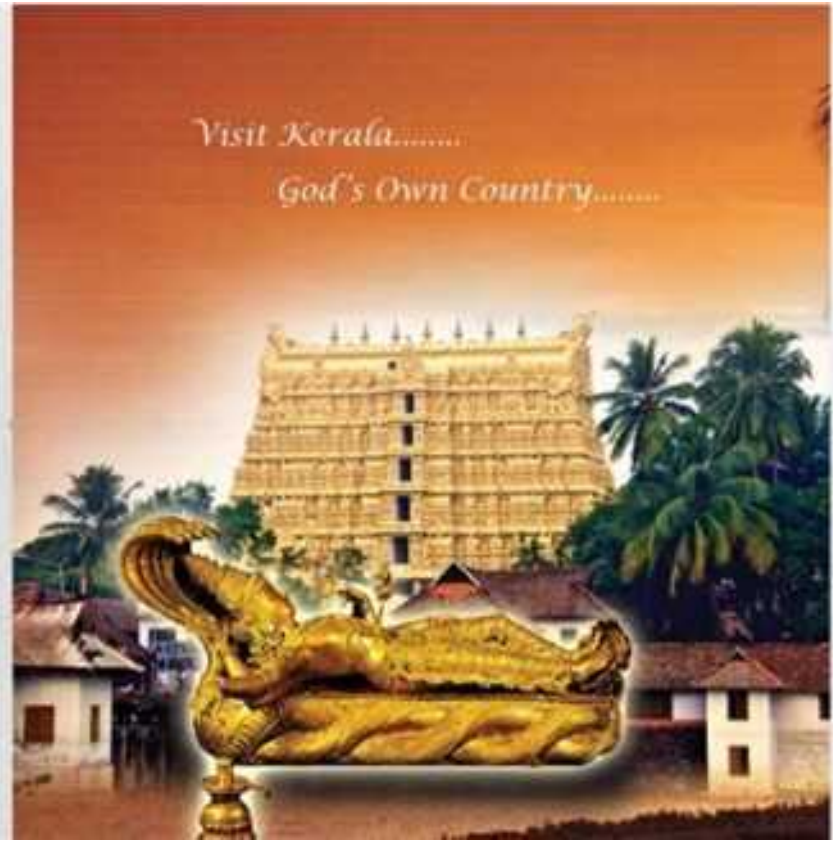
